## FEES

Based on an enrollment of 15 to 19 participants, for the services specified above, the fee per person is \$3,745.

This fee excludes airfare, a \$125 refundable damage deposit, optional medical insurance upgrade (\$65) and optional personal effects coverage (\$90), passport or visa fees if applicable, meals other than those indicated on the itinerary, personal expenses, any MU/APU tuition or administrative fees, textbooks, additional field trips or excursions required by the MU/APU faculty and anything not specified.

These fees are guaranteed not to change as a result of fluctuations in the \$ exchange rate.

## OPTIONAL TRANSPORTATION PACKAGE

On a space-available basis, students may purchase the optional transportation package consisting of round-trip airfare (Raleigh-Durham/Los Angeles to London, Edinburgh to Raleigh-Durham/Los Angeles) and round-trip transfers overseas between the airports and the housing in London and Edinburgh for an additional \$545 excluding mandatory additional U.S. government and airline-imposed departure taxes, fees and fuel surcharges of \$435 (subject to change) for which students will be billed separately.

A minimum of 10 students must purchase each flight for it to be offered.
