Most of you have either volunteered to help with the MU Recycling Program or have at least noticed the blue bins around campus. There have been a slew of questions. So we will take this time to answer a few of them.

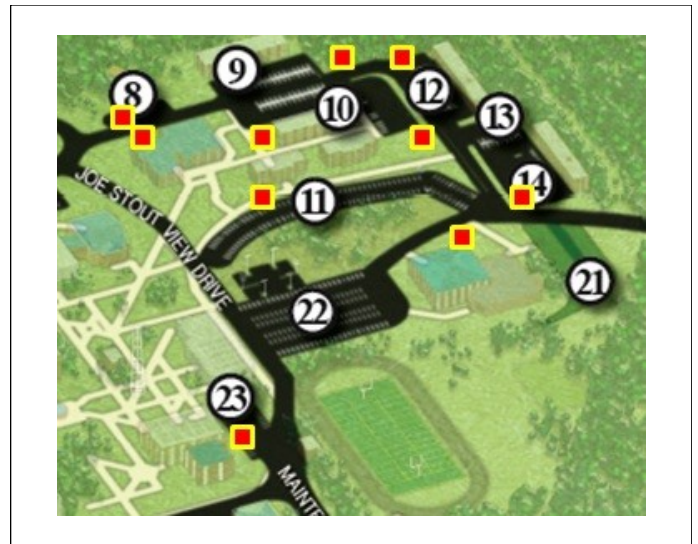
Q: When does the Recycling need to be at the curb for pickup?

A: by Thursday Morning. Pickup usually occurs around 8am on Thursday so you might have to put it out late on Wednesday.

Q: Do we really need to separate the different type of recyclables?

A: YES, the city who picks up recycling at your home allows for mixed recycling. Since we are industry we are required by the county to separate between the following.

- Plastic
- Aluminum
- Paper

Q: If the can is full, where do I add the rest of the recyclables?

A: If your bin becomes full please just use a clear plastic trash bag and continue to separate in the plastic bags and place bags next to bin for Thursday pickup.

NOT be able to handle ANY chemicals until the training is completed. This is a federal mandate.

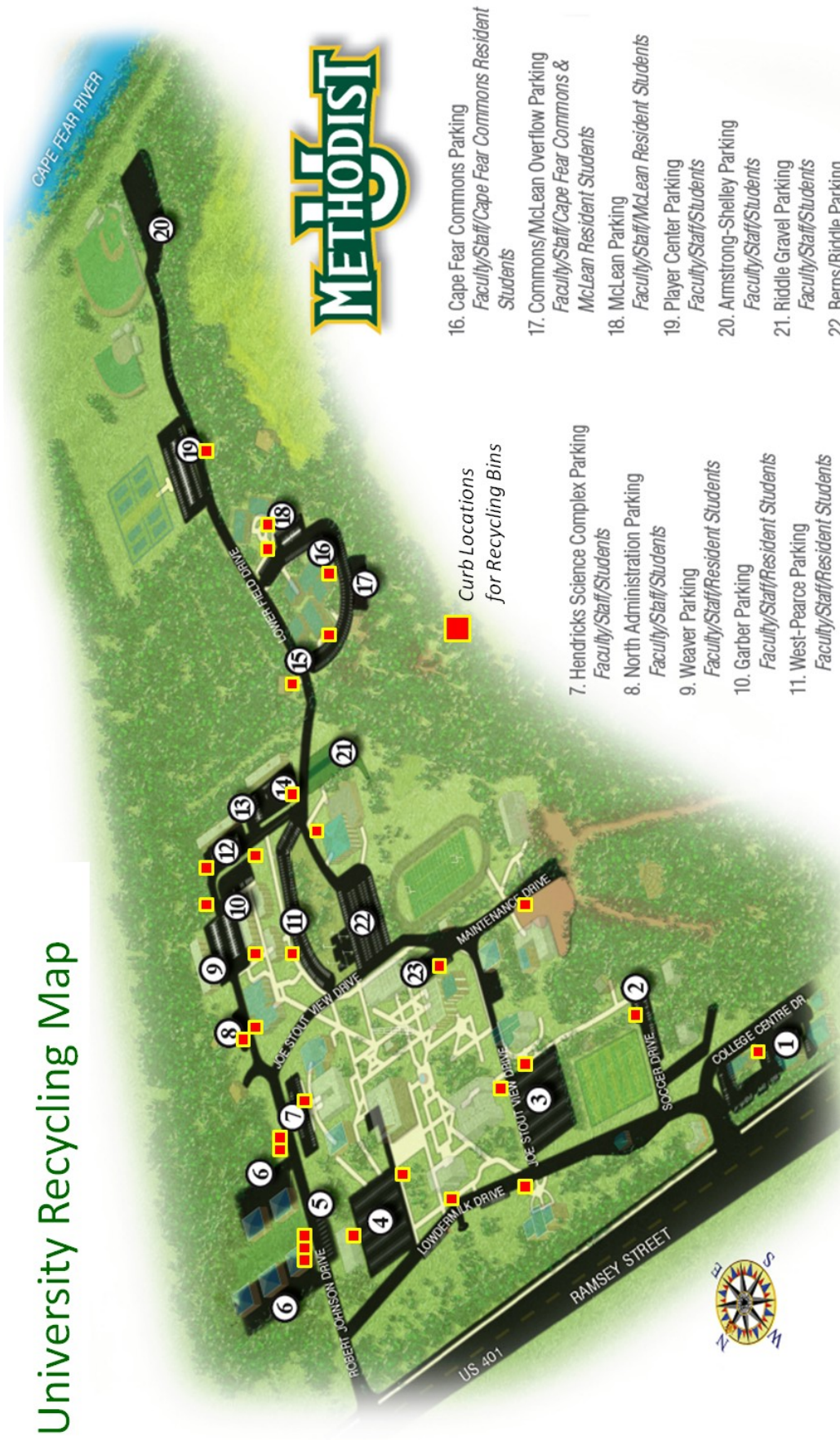
This also goes for all work studies that work around chemicals or harmful items in your department.
