Does your child love to play basketball? Are you eager to develop their talent? Then the Methodist University Coed Winter Basketball Camp 2007 is the place to be! Whether they are just starting out, or on their way to turning pro... Methodist University has something to offer every aspiring young player.

Facilities

The Coed Basketball Camp is held on the beautiful, spacious Methodist University campus in Fayetteville, North Carolina. On-court instruction will take place in the March F. Riddle Center. This 1,200-seat arena is home to the Monarchs and provides a spacious teaching and playing locale for the camp. The air-conditioned center houses the arena, a training room, film/lecture room, dressing rooms, and a Nautilus-equipped weight room.

Ages

The camp is open to boys and girls in grades 3 through 12. Previous team or competitive experience is not required, but all campers will need a desire to improve their skills.

Cost

The registration fee is \$75.00 and includes three days of instruction, eligibility to compete for camp awards, and an official Methodist University Camp T-shirt. A non-refundable deposit of \$20.00 and the registration application are due prior to the camp.

Discounts

Team discounts of \$5.00 per camper are available for groups of five (5) or more team members attending the camp. Please check appropriate box on application and send team registration forms together.

Registration

Registration will be held from 8:00 - 9:00 A.M. on Wednesday, December 19 in the lobby of the March F. Riddle Center. Activities will begin promptly at 9:00 A.M. each day and conclude at 4:00 P.M. The camp will end at noon on Friday, December 21. Gym supervision will be available from 8:00 A.M. until 5:00 P.M. to help accommodate working parents.

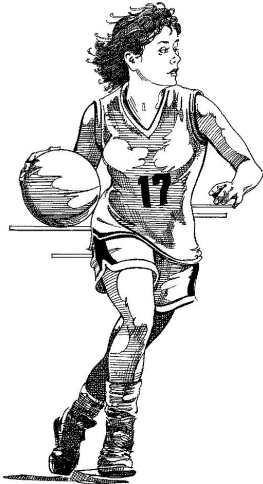
