



Nurse Practitioner or Physician Assistant (NIGHTS)

Job Summary:

Assists the cardiologists in the delivery of patient care services for the Cardiology patient population. Evaluate and manage care of patients undergoing cardiac procedures, including history taking and physical examination, ordering and interpreting diagnostic testing, and clinical management of post-procedures. Coordinates admission and discharge planning. Provides case management services to patients in privileged hospitals. Conducts non-invasive cardiac diagnostic testing in collaboration with cardiologists. Administers medications and orders appropriate laboratory and diagnostic procedures. Writes orders in charts and give orders. Provides education to patients and families as needed. Reviews laboratory reports and other diagnostic reports. Provides telephone coverage for hospital/clinical problems called in by patients, nurses, caregivers, and others. The job also includes patient advocacy, teaching, performance improvement and other duties assigned by supervising physician.

Education & Training:

Must have Master's degree in nursing or graduated from an Accredited Physician Assistant Program and maintain licensure as a certified registered nurse practitioner or Physician Assistant certification. ACLS and BLS certification required.

Work Orientation & Experience:

Licensed, Adult Nurse Practitioner or Physician Assistant to provide in-hospital cardiology coverage and support for Cary Cardiology patients within the WakeMed and Rex Hospital System. Prefer a minimum of two years of critical care and/or cardiologist experience, including ability to competently supervise cardiac stress test tests if needed. Proficiency in 12 lead EKG interpretations. Cardiology/Cardiovascular Surgery/Electrophysiology experience preferred. Critical care and cardiac cath. lab experience highly preferred.

Ability to: a) handle multiple priorities; b) work independently and take initiative in achieving goals; c) communicate effectively with patients, medical staff and team members; d) adapt hours of availability to variable changing needs of Cary Cardiology; and e) maintain confidentiality with patient and team member information.
