

North Hall Classroom

Desktop computer teaching station with Laptop accessibility with both HDMI and VGA with audio connectivity using dual projectors and Smartboard technology controlled by a Crestron Switching device.

The North Hall classroom uses a Crestron Switching device operating two LightRay interactive projectors through a desktop or laptop computer.

Operating procedure:

1. Turn on projectors using the Creston Switch below. (Select on)
 - a. This provides 2 interactive workspaces
2. Turn on the Desktop computer and Select HDMI or
3. Connect your laptop using the HDMI cable and the USB cable and select RGB
 - a. This provides 2 interactive workspaces



You can set your monitors to duplicate, extend or 2 separate projections.

How the Projection system is set to work:

- All three screen are set to duplicate Projector #2
- Projector #2 and the Monitor work in tandem.
- HDMI sound originates though Projector #1
- You can shut down Projector #2 and continue to see Projector #1 and the desktop Monitor.
- If you extend Projector number one both the desktop Monitor and Projector #2 extend.
- If you choose to use Projector#2 HDMI sound is lost.
