

On Campus Study Spaces



Problem

- Spaces on campus are underutilized
- Many of these spaces would be useful as indoor gathering spaces for students







Survey Results

- 44% of students somewhat dissatisfied with current study spaces
- 89% of respondents said they would use study spaces more often if more were available
- 85% of believe either Davis Memorial Library or the Trustee's Building would be the most convenient place for these spaces

Ideas

- Convert library basement into study/gathering spaces.
- Rearrange the main floor of the library
- Convert unused offices to study rooms (Trustees)
- Expand the library's second floor to accommodate more meeting spaces

Constraints

- Cost cannot be too high
- Spaces need to be easily accessible
- COVID-19 restrictions
- Noise containing
- Complete renovations while students are on campus
