For example, a computer science or computer information technology major must fulfill the Liberal Arts Elective requirement by taking a course with a prefix other than CSC, and an English major must fulfill the Liberal Arts Elective requirement by taking a course with a prefix other than ENG or WRI.
- 3. Courses in areas listed above that emphasize professional preparation and pedagogy cannot be used to fulfill the Liberal Arts Elective. The following courses are not Liberal Arts Electives: ENG 2600, ENG 3600, ENG 3620, LAN 2600, LAN 3300, MAT 1060, and MAT 2060.
