About Methodist University

Methodist University is a private four-year liberal arts university committed to respect for diversity and recognition of the dignity and worth of all human beings. The University is historically related to the United Methodist Church, but welcomes students from all religious backgrounds. Methodist University was first chartered by the state of North Carolina on Nov. 1, 1956, as a senior, coeducational, residential college of liberal arts and sciences. It is accredited by the Commission of Colleges of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools to award doctor's, master's, bachelor's, and associate degrees. The University is composed of the School of Arts and Humanities, the Reeves School of Business, the School of Public Affairs, the School of Health Sciences, and the School of Science and Human Development.

Academics

- Methodist University offers more than 80 undergraduate degrees, four master's degrees, and two doctoral degree programs.
- ◆ The University has top-rated programs in business, golf management, tennis management, and resort and hotel management. We also have a successful forensic science program and environmental and occupational management program, both with required course work in simulations and the disaster scene simulator. Some of the other popular majors include nursing, accounting, marketing, global studies, and engineering
- Interdisciplinary liberal arts curriculum
- 60 opportunities for travel and study abroad offered every academic year
- ◆ 15:1 student-to-faculty ratio
- 94 percent of classes have less than 30 students



Student Community

- Small urban-setting campus
- Approximately 2,400 students from more than 41 states and 70 countries
- 90 percent of students live on campus

Financial Aid

- Average first-year Presidential Scholarship: \$16,400
- Average financial aid award: \$ 17,200
- Over \$20 million of institutional funds allocated for academic and need-based aid
- ◆ 93 percent of MU students qualify for financial assistance
- 37 percent of freshmen receive a Presidential Scholarship

- Modern housing facilities throughout the 2.5 km² campus in a natural woodland setting, offering a fun and fulfilling residential life
- 20 residential buildings, including traditional residence halls, Greek housing, and on-campus apartments
- 24-hour security, cable TV, wireless internet, and a resident advisor on each floor

- More than 100 student clubs and organizations
