Methodist University is proud to announce Session XXXIV of the West Point Leadership Program (WPLP).

Session XXXIV* at Greensboro Police Department, August 23 – November 22, 2022

The WPLP course purpose is: To inspire police leaders to develop an *informed*, *systematic*, and *dynamic* approach to leading in police organizations.

The WPLP is an adaptation of the third-year course PL300, Military Leadership completed by all cadets at the U. S. Military Academy at West Point, New York.

The course examines and integrates leadership in organizations from four perspectives: the individual, the group, the leader, and the organization. Session XXXIV will be held co-hosted with the Greensboro, North Carolina Police Department.

The course consists of 13 class days (on each Tuesday) and 3 online examinations.

One class day will incorporate a Leader Terrain Walk at the Guilford Courthouse Revolutionary War battlefield. Students will participate in assessments of their followership style, interpersonal skills as a leader or officer in a community policing environment, and organizational characteristics of greatness. The registration cost for the course is \$750 per student. Students will receive an invoice when the class begins, so it is not necessary to process payment before the class begins. All course materials will be provided in digital format and are supplemented by a course web site and online video lectures.
