

OUTCOME MEASURE - STUDENT PROGRESSION AND COMPLETION

Outcome Measure - Student Progression and Completion Report focuses on providing student progression and completion information on all entering undergraduate degree-seeking students. Tracking is by First-time students and Transfer Students by cohorts based on the academic year they entered Methodist University, looking at their progression at the four, six and eight year marks. First-time students and Transfer Students are further broken down by enrollment status (full-time or part-time) and whether they received a Pell Grant. Tracking of student progression and completion also includes whether students transferred to another institution.

For the 2009-2010 Cohort, overall 32 percent had graduated after eight years, 34 percent of First-time students and 30 percent of Transfer Students. Overall 52 percent had transferred to another institution, 52 percent of First-time students and 53 percent of Transfer Students. There is no trend data at this time since this is the initial year reported.
