ACADEMIC PROFILE FOR FIRST-TIME FRESHMEN*

- ◆ Average GPA = 3.56

- ◆ Scored between 1120 and 1250 on the SAT

Five enrolled U.S. freshmen were Wright Scholars and received full-tuition scholarships.

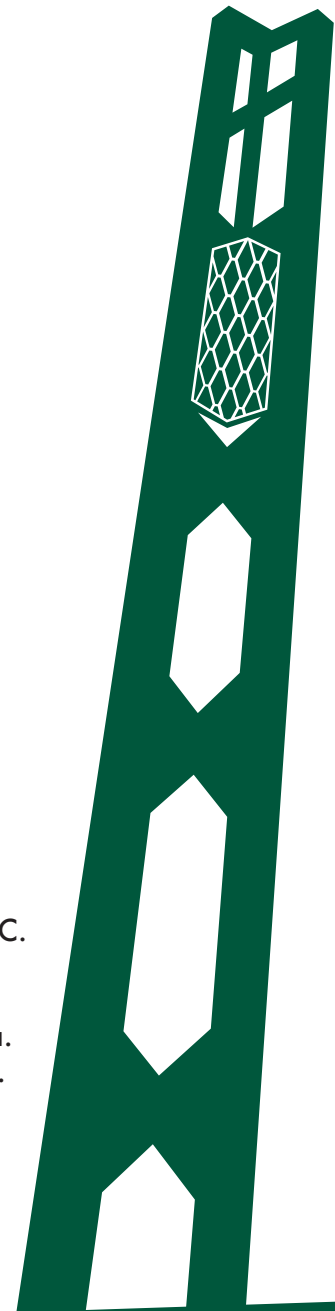

VALUE

- ♦ MU graduates consistently rank in the top 30% of graduates of North Carolina four-year institutions when measuring median salaries 10 years after initial enrollment
- ♦ 97% of incoming freshmen receive financial assistance
- ♦ \$34,268 is the average financial award for incoming residential freshmen.
- ♦ \$17,489 is the average cost after financial aid for incoming residential freshman – similar to the cost of living on campus at an in-state public school
- ♦ \$22,740 is the average Presidential Scholarship for incoming freshmen

- ♦ **Top-tier** ranking in *U.S. News & World Report*
- ♦ **98%** first-year first-time pass rate over the past five years on the PA National Certifying Exam for Physician Assistant program graduates
