## TRANSFER STUDENTS

Methodist University welcomes our new transfer students to campus! As a new transfer student, it's especially important to make sure you understand your transfer credit evaluation and your pathway to graduate here at MU. ## STUDENT FINANCIAL SERVICES

It is to the student's benefit to settle his or her account with Student Financial Services before coming to campus in January. Payment arrangements must be made by Dec. 15, 2023. Payment plans can be established online through Nelnet. For questions contact 910.630.7284 or visit [methodist.edu/officeservices/sfs](http://methodist.edu/officeservices/sfs). Credit card payments can only be made online through the myMU Student portal. Residential students who have settled their accounts with Student Financial Services prior to Saturday, Jan. 13, 2024, should have their Student ID card made in the Campus Services Building before proceeding to their assigned residence halls.

## IMMUNIZATIONS

To attend on-campus courses and/or live in an on-campus residence hall, a Certificate of Immunization or record of immunization must be presented on or before the date the student first registers for a quarter or semester. North Carolina law requires that students receive the following immunizations: three Diphtheria/Tetanus (one must be Tdap and one dose within the past 10 years), three doses of Polio, two doses of Measles (titer required if no vaccine), two doses of Mumps (titer required if no vaccine), one dose of Rubella (titer required if no vaccine), three doses of Hepatitis B (if born after July 1, 1994), one dose of Varicella (if born on or after April 1, 2001 or titer if no vaccine).

Failure to submit a complete immunization record can result in dismissal from the university. Students who have not sent their immunization record to the Health Center should do so immediately. Additional immunizations may be required depending on the student's degree program. Call 910.630.7164 or email [muhc@methodist.edu](mailto:muhc@methodist.edu) if you have questions.

## INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY SERVICES

The CAC Lab in the Trustees Building, room 275, will be open for use by students. Students should have received an email account and network username and password in a letter from the Admissions Office. Please have the following information available to receive assistance with your email account: student ID number and full name. ## COURSE SCHEDULING

Students will need to connect with their academic and career advisor to get registered for Spring 2024 classes. You can find your advisor's contact information in your myMU Portal under the advising tab. Your academic and career advisor is excited to meet with you to help you get started.

## FOOD SERVICE

Food service will begin with dinner on Sunday, Jan. 14 in the Green & Gold Dining Hall. Regular food service hours for the dining hall and the Lion's Den will begin Monday, Jan. 15. Parents and guests are welcome to dine with us for \$9.75+ tax per person per meal. Residential meal plans begin at dinner on Sunday, Jan. 14. Commuting students are encouraged to take advantage of the meals offered in the Green & Gold Dining Hall. Information about meal plan options for commuting students will be available in the Green & Gold Dining Hall. The flexibility and low cost of various meal plans makes Aramark a convenient option for commuters as well as residential students.

## FINANCIAL AID

Methodist University understands that financial matters are a primary concern to students and their families. You are highly encouraged to have federal financial aid forms completed before you arrive in January.

## PARKING

Parking for residential students with vehicles is available in front of each residence hall, in the lot behind Pearce and West Residence Halls, and between the Berns Student Center and the March F. Riddle Center. Parking is not permitted in the fire lanes in front of the residence halls. Parking for commuter students is available in the lots near the Trustees Building and Huff Concert Hall and between the Berns Student Center and the March F. Riddle Center.

All commuter students and residential students with vehicles are required to have their vehicles registered with the Public Safety Office no later than Tuesday, Jan. 16. Parking permits may be purchased online (using a debit or credit card) through your myMU Portal before arrival (go to Student Life tab, Vehicle Registration Form). Each student is required to register their vehicle on the myMU portal even if you plan to pay in person at the Student Financial Services Office. You will have the opportunity to pick up a parking permit Monday, Jan. 8 through Friday, Jan. 12, and Tuesday Jan. 16 in the Campus Services Building. Permits cost \$100 for the spring semester and may be paid by cash, check, money order, credit or debit card at the Student Financial Services Office.

## POST OFFICE BOX

The Methodist University Post Office in the Berns Student Center will be open on Tuesday, Jan. 16, (8 a.m.-4 p.m.), and

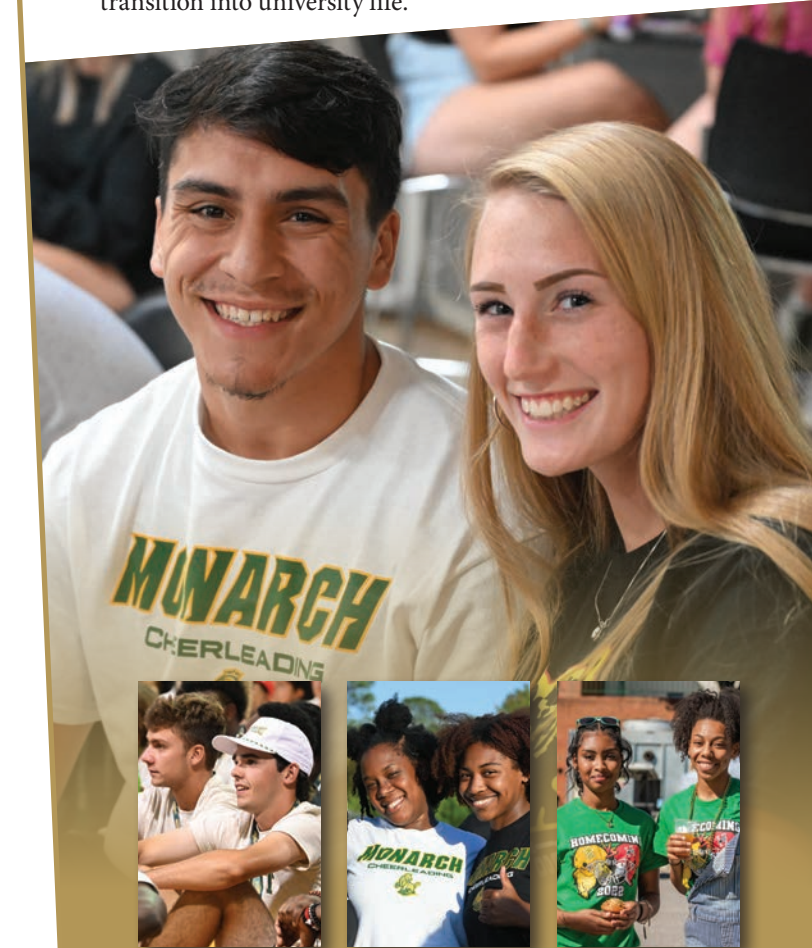
students will need to go by this office to receive their campus mailbox.
