Purpose

Methodist University recognizes that the very cornerstone of its ongoing commitment to a campus-wide culture of excellence is the quality of its faculty. It is, therefore, appropriate to identify and recognize faculty whose exemplary mentoring and dedicated service significantly enrich the university community.

Criteria

Nominees should demonstrate excellence in one or more of the following evaluation areas:

1. **Outstanding Mentorship:** Evidence of consistent, compassionate, and impactful mentorship that positively influences student development, academic success, and vocational discernment.
2. **Student-Centered Service:** The Evidence of a commitment to initiatives and programs that significantly enhance student experiences in and out of the classroom and overall student well-being.
3. **Community Building:** Evidence of efforts that foster inclusive, collaborative, and supportive learning communities within and beyond the classroom.
4. **Institutional Engagement:** Active participation and leadership in university service, including contributions to committees, task forces, shared governance, and campus-wide initiatives.



We encourage nominations of faculty who go above and beyond to nurture meaningful connections, a sense of belonging, and embodying Methodist University's dedication to student success and institutional excellence.
